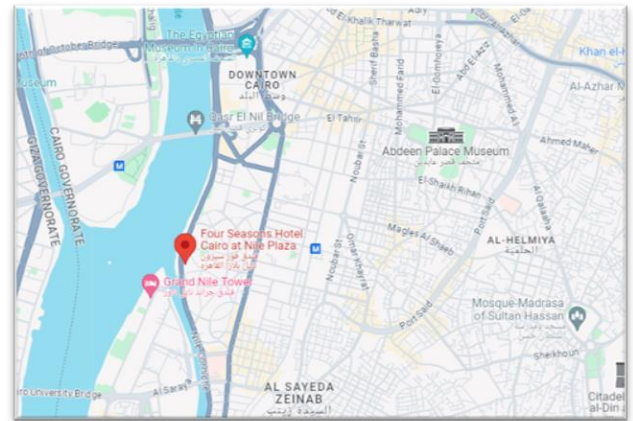

### **Entry to Egypt and Visa:**

All delegates must hold a valid passport or travel document with a minimum validity of 6 months from date of departure.

All delegates need to obtain an entry visa through Egyptian Embassies, consulates and high commissions in their countries and should apply as the soonest. The CBE is **attaching** with this logistics note a general visa facilitation letters (Arabic/English) in order to facilitate obtaining the entry visa to Egypt.

## **Travel and Medical Requirements:**

All Covid-19 instruction for passengers travelling to Egypt are lifted effective on 17<sup>th</sup> June 2022 (no need for PCR or Covid-19 vaccination certificate).

The government of Egypt requires an online registration through <http://https.visitegypt.gov.eg/> for all travelers who are entering Egypt and a proof of yellow fever, Polio, Cholera and Ebola vaccine if you are arriving from a country with risk of these diseases: List of Countries and Vaccination requirements as following:

### **Yellow Fever Certificate is required upon arrival to Egypt from the below countries: -**
