




#### **Statistical Activities About Digitalization**




level of digitalization at your

Does your institution currently have any digitalization strategies in place?




How important is digitization for your institution?








## What types of security challenges does your institution face?




# How does your institution ensure the security of the statistical data?








# Has your institution begun implementing machine learning or Al technologies in any of its processes or operations?




#### Which areas are AI/ML being applied?








# What are the main challenges your institution faces or anticipates facing in adopting machine learning or Al technologies?
